6.3 ROOM OCCUPANCY CHANGES

As you probably know, Cloyne's house occupancy is increasing by 20 next semester.

The easiest thing to do is to revert to the room occupancies Cloyne has had in the past. Adds up to exactly 140. However, there is a new factor in the mix. I have been informed by Central Office that 4 students in wheelchairs are interested in living in Cloyne next semester- which is fantastic news. Cloyne currently has 3 rooms that can accommodate wheelchairs: W1D, W1E, and W1F. However, the last two of these rooms have been doubles in the past. Due to the extra equipment needed (like a wheelchair) the reality is that members in wheelchairs would find it very difficult to live in a double. A possibility that would make the house more accessible would be to convert the two wheelchair accessible doubles into singles and to increase the occupancy of other rooms. The rooms I suggest increasing the occupancy in are W2C and W3C- these are spacious doubles that can become triples.

Option A) to keep room occupancies the same as they were in previous years

Option B) to turn W1E and W1F into singles and make W2C and W3C into triples

6.4 Dual Flush Toilets

Install dual flush toilet inserts in all toilets in Cloyne

Cost: \$0- to be paid for by a grant

Savings: reduced water usage over time.

Install date: over the course of the next 6 months
