I wondered if you had any suggestions for venues, I have friends at Loth and could do it there but thought to inquire with you in case we had an even better option.

Here are the video's - we'll watch around 4 of them and have a facilitated discussion.

Something like this:

"Come watch short films of UC Berkeley professor Robert Reich explaining economic inequality and discuss the issues with fellow BSC alumni. Yoni Landau, BSC alum and Executive Director of Inequality Media, the organization responsible for producing the

videos, will be facilitating." time and location to be discussed (1 Minute)

b. Other:
