- b. Funding request from the house account
 - i. My name is Luke, and I am contacting you on the behalf of Thought Lounge, a student-run organization which aims to create safe spaces for dialogue. We think a ton of people at Cloyne would be interested, so we were hoping to make an announcement as soon as possible, perhaps at one of your lunches/dinners? (I'm also looking into coops to board at this upcoming year, so it would be awesome if I could stop by anyway!).

Here's how a Thought Lounge works: 3-6 participants meet in person. Each person leads a 12-minute discussion on a topic which strikes passion in them. Participants are usually strangers and

unaware of the topics the other participants will bring. There is one Host that organizes and moderates the discussion, in particular by upholding the Thought Lounge's 5 Agreements for Dialogue. After all topics have been presented, participants use a whiteboard or piece of paper to connect the topics together.

The conversations you have in Thought Lounge are eye-opening, beautiful, and unlike anything else. That's why hundreds of Berkeley students have participated so far. We are hosting a few Thought Lounges per week during the summer, and will host Thought Lounges nearly every day during the fall/spring semesters. I hope that Cloyne will join the conversation!
